- Step 1 Chemically clean the filter with <u>BAQUACIL® Universal Filter Cleaner</u>.
- Step 2Brush pool walls and floor daily, and filter regularly during treatment, until your pool is free from
visible algae. Continue to either Step 3(a) or Step 3(b), depending upon the water clarity.
