## Solution

Scale deposits (usually in the form of white, gray or brownish chalky deposits on pool walls and fixtures) are the precipitate that forms as a result of unbalanced water. This could be a high pH, high total alkalinity, high calcium hardness and/or a combination thereof.

Take a sample of your pool water to your authorized poolife® Dealer for a full analysis. Balance your water according to your dealer's recommendations. To avoid further scaling take a sample of the pool water to your poolife® Dealer each month for a detailed analysis.

Use <u>poolife® Tile Cleaner Rx</u> to remove scale deposits on all pool surfaces. Add <u>poolife® Intensive Stain</u> <u>Prevention</u> weekly to keep scaling from occurring.
